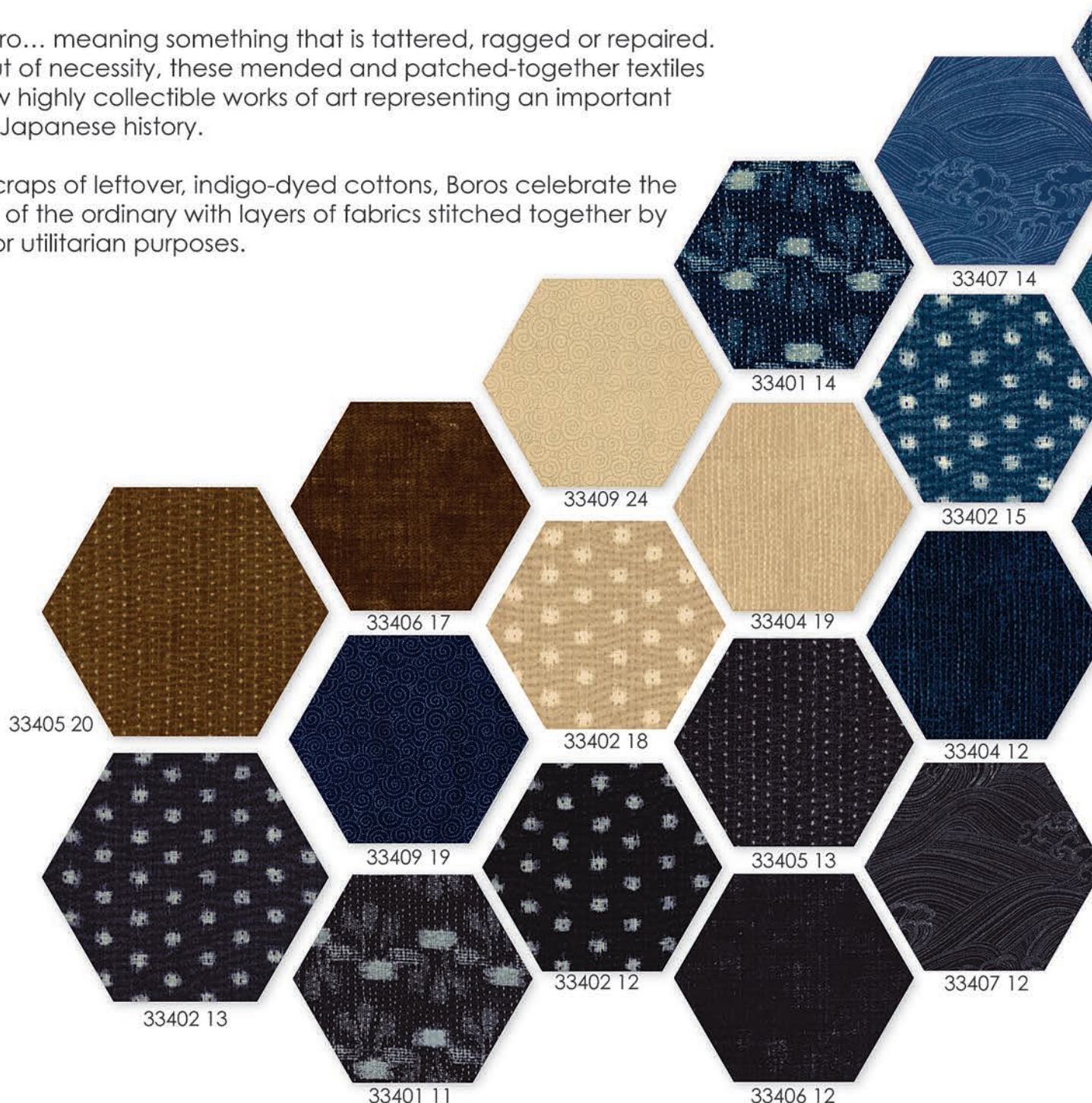


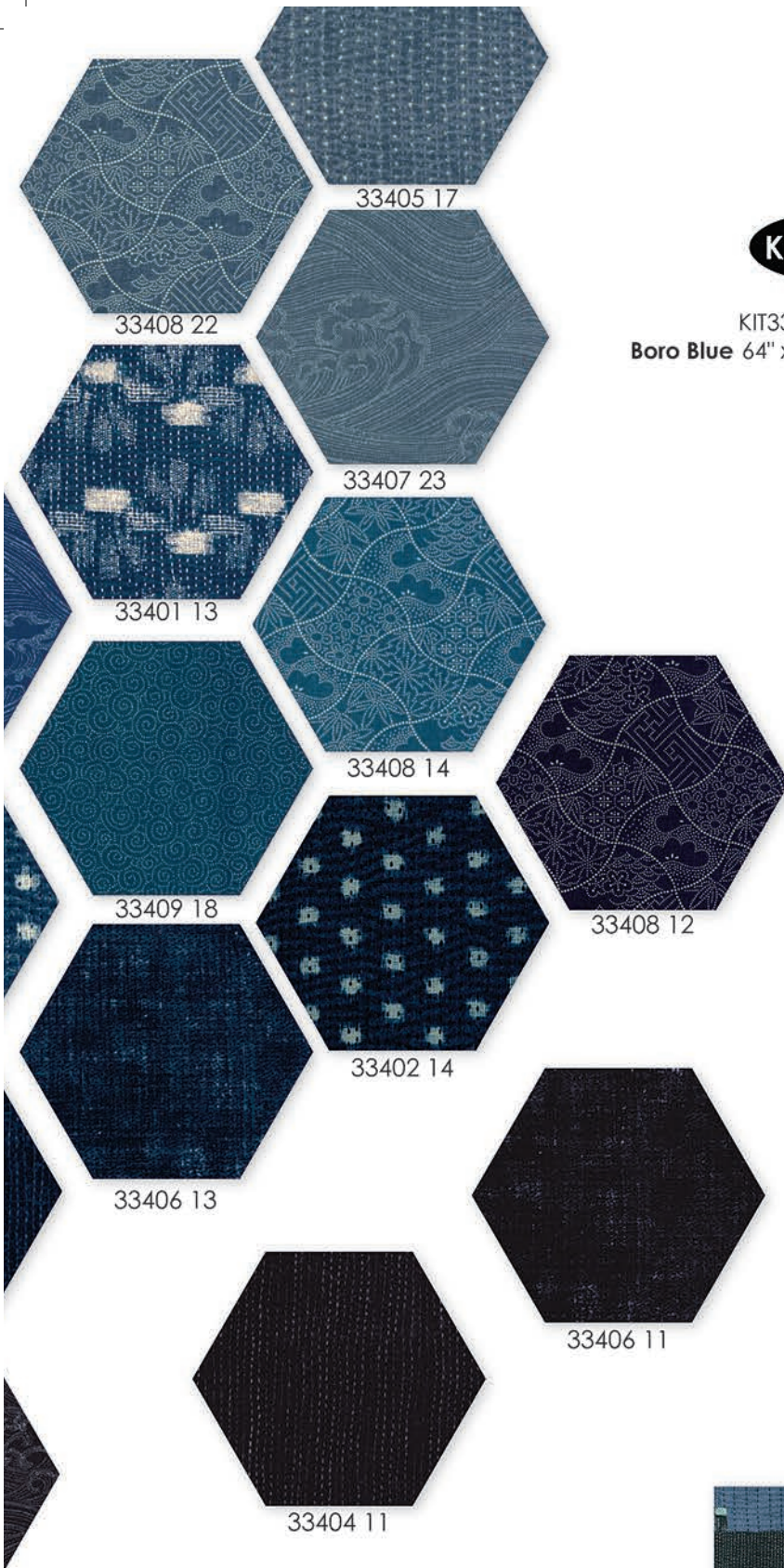
# BORO

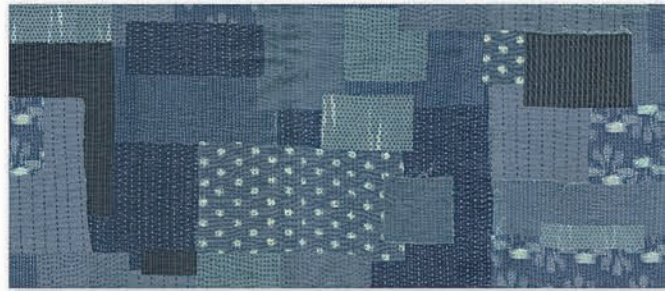

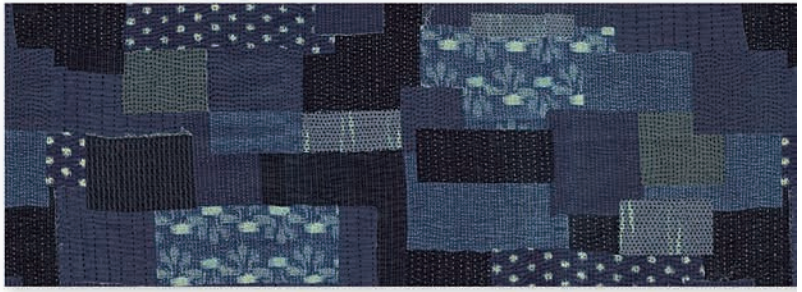
